The presence of a semi-terrestrial isopod (assuming they have the same biology than those current from the immediate supralittoral zone), indicates that some Cretaceous French forests were very close to the seashore (Girard et al. 2008). These coastal forests may have promoted the expansion of the Oniscidea, by offering new ecological niches rather similar to those of the supralittoral, with high humidity, a gradient of salinity, abundant food, and shelters.
